Debbi and *Mike Kostiv* will be traveling a lot next year. Consequently, we need a new Vice President and event planner for 2024.

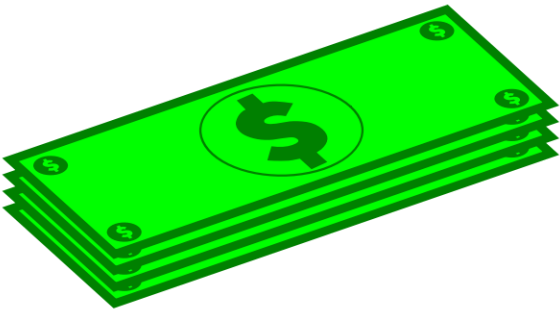
Harvey Bandy reported on progress at the Awful Waffle. The fenders are "gorgeous." A new timing rod of the correct
